ASD: Autism Spectrum Disorder

CAMHS: Child and Adolescent Mental Health Services

EHCP: Education, Health & Care Plan

EP: Educational Psychologist

HI: Hearing Impairment

LA: Local Authority

MLD: Moderate Learning Difficulty

MSI: Multi-sensory impairment

OT: Occupational Therapy/Therapist

PD: Physical Disability

PMLD: Profound and Multiple Learning Difficulties

PT: Physiotherapy/Physiotherapist

SALT: Speech & Language Therapy/Therapist

SEND: Special Educational Needs and Disabilities

SENDCo: Special Educational Needs and Disabilities Co-ordinator

SLCN: Speech, Language & Communication Needs

SLD: Severe Learning Difficulties

SpLD: Specific Learning Difficulties

STAPS: Specialist Teacher and Psychology Service

TA: Teaching Assistant

VI: Visual Impairment

SEND Support: If your child is on the SEND register, they will be receiving SEND support.

PSA: Parent Support Advisor

LLS: Language and Literacy Specialist
