Please accept our apologies for the lateness of this letter. You will be aware of the ongoing discussions between government and teaching unions around the reopening of primary schools in Tier 4 areas.

As a result, Acorns nursery will be only open to key worker and vulnerable children:

Remote learning will be provided for pupils in the affected classes via Seesaw. If you are unable to access Seesaw, please contact school for a paper pack of work.

If your child is in the above class, someone from school will contact you to ask if you require a place.

All other classes are open in school. However, this could change depending on government advice, staffing levels and Covid-19 related absences.

Home learning
