Remote learning following school closure



We would like to thank our parents and carers for your continued support. We realise how challenging the uncertainty of the pandemic is for everyone and we are grateful for all the kind messages we have received. We look forward to the children returning when it is safe for us to all be together as a school community.

Remote learning

The government have directed schools to close to all pupils from Tuesday 5th January 2021 until February half term, except for those classified as vulnerable or those whose parents are key workers.

We realise the challenges this situation can create and know that children learn best in school. However, to ensure that our children continue with their education as best we can, in the safest way for our school community, we are moving all learning online from Wednesday 6th January 2021.

Remote learning expectations:

- Lessons will move online from 6th January 2021
- Pupils are expected to complete core subject learning each day
- Teachers will set maths, English and grammar lessons daily
 - Teachers will set further subjects weekly
- Teachers will mark and respond to your child's learning
- Online lessons will be set on Seesaw. If you do not have a device to access Seesaw, please contact school immediately
- Teachers will provide supplementary work paper packs for children, which can be collected from school fortnightly.

We will keep you updated with any further information as soon as we receive it.
