Covid-19 update

As you will no doubt be aware, Covid-19 guidance for schools changed on 1st April, and can be summarised as follows:

- There is no longer a requirement for pupils to complete regular testing or to test prior to coming back into school. Furthermore, there is also no longer a requirement to test if symptomatic;
- Children and young people who are unwell and have a high temperature should stay at home and, where possible, avoid contact with other people. They can go back to school when they no longer have a high temperature and they are well enough;
- Children and young people who have a positive test result for COVID-19 should not attend school for 3 days after the day of the test;
- Children and young people who live with someone who has a positive COVID-19 test result should continue to attend school as normal.

Ongoing measures

As a school, we will continue to ensure indoor spaces are well-ventilated, and remind the pupils of the importance of good hand and respiratory hygiene.

We will also liaise with the Local Public Health Team, should there be any signs of increased levels of illness.

Whilst society now seems to be operating in a largely pre-pandemic manner, there remain vulnerable members of the community, who continue to need our collective support.
