This is the highest award a school can achieve for the inclusion of all pupils.



What is the Inclusion Quality Mark?

The Inclusion Quality Mark is an award to show the inclusivity of schools. To gain the award, schools must show evidence that they celebrate, accept and respect diversity.

Following an inspection of the school, it is decided if the school is suitable to be awarded the IQM.

Here at Park End Primary, we have successfully been awarded this prestigious award three times since 2019, moving from a Centre of Excellence to a Flagship school in 2022!
