WHY OPAL?

As the school improves play opportunities, you may find we ask you for resources as we make changes about how the children use the school grounds. Your children may get a bit messier, be exposed to more challenges and have greater freedoms.

Please make sure children have warm, waterproof coats in school so we can begin our play adventure!
